St James' Park

St. James's Park is an extension of 23 hectares in the area of Westminster, in the center of London (United Kingdom). It is the oldest of the Royal Parks of the city. It is located at the southern end of the St. James area, which was named in honor of a leper hospital dedicated to St. James the Younger.

St James's Park is surrounded by Buckingham Palace. The park has a small lake, St. James-Park's Lake, with two islands, Duck Island (named after the collection of lake ducks), and West Island. A bridge that crosses the lake offers a magnificent view to the west of Buckingham Palace framed by trees and fountains, and a great view of the main building of the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, to the east.
